Deaf/Hard of Hearing (DHH) Guides Conversation Starter Questions

Here are some of the most common questions parents ask.



General

- 1. What was it like for you to grow up d/Deaf or hard of hearing?
- 2. How would you describe your hearing levels? How do you identify yourself?
- 3. What does it mean to you to be d/Deaf or hard of hearing? Do you sign and/or speak? Why?

Personal

- 1. How did your family help you grow up to be the person you are today? What did they do that you found helpful?
- 2. What hobbies, interests and passions do you have?
- 3. Share a wonderful childhood memory you have.
- 4. What are some challenges you had as a d/Deaf or hard of hearing person and how did you overcome them?
- 5. What is the relationship and communication with your family like?

Hearing Equipment & Communication Technology

- 1. What technology do you use in your day-to-day life (at home, at school, in the community)?
- 2. What was your experience using various equipment and communication growing up?
- 3. Has that changed over time as you've found what works best for you?
- 4. If you do not use hearing equipment, why not?

Education

- 1. When you were young, what did your parents do to support you in developing language(s) and friendships?
- 2. Share some of your educational journey including accomplishments and how you overcame challenges. What did support for access look like at school?
- 3. How did you and your family make your educational choices? Did you go to a school for d/Deaf children, a specialized program in a public school, or a public school without specialized support? How were these experiences for you and your family?
- 4. How important was it for you to meet other deaf and hard of hearing peers?
