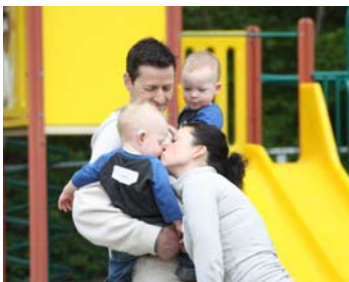
Topics will include:
